Secretary Report: Shana Hogan: Shana emailed the Minutes to Board Members. No further discussion.

The first two day extravaganza at Lincoln Air Park on Oct. 8-9. It began on Saturday with Solo Trials completion for 32 drivers, with Mark Walker serving as course designer with Dave Pape as event master. The final points Solo competition of the season, #7, was held on Sunday for 101 drivers, with Ben Tusa as course designer/eventmaster. The Corvette Club shared the site (and expenses) both days to hold their own solo. The Mustang Club led a Gymkana on Sunday.

We were fortunate to have a Focus RS to see and drive, courtesy of Ford Motor Company and their rep, Taylor. The Solo Trials drivers managed to shred the tires on Saturday, so the car sat idle on Sunday. thank you Taylor and Ford!

RallyCross #8 was held at 1-80 Speedway with course designer Marty Choyeske and 17 drivers competing.

Jim Woods has offered his land for a extra RallyCross, but at present he cannot commit to a date. I only see two viable dates, November 13 and Dec 11. Dec 11 may not draw many drivers. The K.C. region has a RallyCross near St. Joe on Sat. Dec. 2nd, and I recommend supporting that one instead. I recommend tabling this opportunity and declaring it a successful year.

Thank you Dave Pape and Mike LoveJoy for leading such a successful, and eventful, year for Solo and RallyCross. That is all, for now. I look forward to more fun and thrills in 2017."

October Monthly BoG Minutes con't . . .

“October finished up our last points event for the RallyCross program. It’s still hard to believe we had 8 races for this season. Of those events, two were double-header weekends with a RallyCross school and a Twilight Rally in April and a Midwest Division Championship in September. We averaged right around 21 entries per event with the highest attended event bringing in 27 entries. While this season’s average is only slightly higher than the 2015 Season turnout there were three more races included. This reflects a more consistent attendance rate throughout the season.

This is largely due to growing number of regulars that are filling the ranks and promoting our RallyCross program. These key participants are helping drive our program forward.

I was also proud to see a strong showing of NRSCCA members representing our region at National Championships this year. From podiums to pylons, our Nebraska Region competitors competed well on The National stage. We were fortunate to have such high-caliber drivers in our program. Many of these drivers were part of the RallyCross School earlier in the season, so it’s encouraging to see them do well at Nationals.

There’s also been added exposure for our RallyCross events from social media. Thanks to Facebook events being shared through various car clubs and racing outlets, more people are discovering our RallyCross events and trying them out. Even if people weren’t racing, the spectators, photographers, and general following the program has gained this year has also helped contribute to the success of this season.

8 events over a 9 month period, 12 meals fed to 166 entries, and hundreds of cones brutally muted by a white Evo. I think it’s safe to say the 2016 season is something we can be proud of. I’d like to thank everyone who helped contribute to the strength of our RallyCross program this year and look forward to more racing in the dirt next season.”

Nebraska Auto Racing Hall of Fame 2016

On Friday, October 14 seven new members were inducted into the Hall of Fame. Those new members are; Marlin Bogner, Kearney, Noel Chadd, Lincoln, Fred Garbers, Columbus, John Larson, Lincoln, C. B. "Pop" Miller, Gothenburg, Tim Schulz, Lincoln and **Tom Gutowski, Omaha. (Tom is an X-NRSCCA member and was a club race driver)** Has done about everything in motorsports from driver to promoter to official. He is currently competition Director for IMCA.

TOM GUTOWSKI

Tom was born on January 17, 1946, and grew up in a typical post World War II blue collar family home in the northeast Elyria, Ohio. His dad had a friend, who raced a coupe on dirt and it was there that he received his introduction to auto racing and he was hooked.



Gutowski bought his first Corvette in the spring of 1975. It was a 1966 coupe, 327/300 hp, 4 speed and a bolt-in roll bar assembly. He joined the Cornhusker Corvette Club (CCC) after moving to Omaha. It was with the club that Tom learned about precision driving via slalom and road coarse racing against time.

Over the winter of 1978-79 he sold the '69 and purchased a dedicated road racing Corvette from his attorney, Phil Kneifl (NRSCCA), also a member of CCC, and a car that was constructed and also driven by local racer and Corvette Repair owner, Al Druedow (NRSCCA). It was a 1963 chassis with a 1966 body and no engine. After upgrades to the roll

cage, safety equipment, chassis components and the installation of an aluminum head L88 big block, Gutowski was ready to take on the challenge of competing in the Race Prepared division of NCCC. In 1979, he won the Race Prepared division at the National Convention in Pueblo Motorsports Park in Pueblo, CO.

In the fall of 1979, Tom attended SCCA road racing driver's school in Brainerd, MN, to obtain his SCCA License and won his school race. The next year he went SCCA road racing and won the Midwest Division Regional B Production championship. Gutowski was leading the championship the following year but elected to give up his points at midseason and race in some National Division events with mixed results. In 1984, a high speed crash at the road course in Wentzville, MO, near St. Louis, ended with a destroyed race car. With SCCA's announced switch to professionally built, tube framed GT1 Trans-Am type cars in 1984, Tom had a decision to make about staying in road racing.

It was at this time that his friends, who had recently bought Eagle Raceway. In 1985 they put together a deal with Budweiser to sponsor the first registered IMCA Modified in Nebraska and offered it to Tom. He accepted and in the early fall of 1984, and in the ensuing years he raced everywhere he could with modest success.

The years gave him more new opportunities, managing and promoting many tracks.

On November 6, 2006, Tom signed a contract with IMCA, was appointed its Competition Director. Tom has averaged working close to 50 tracks and multi-day events a year, including off-season trade shows such as PRI. He has probably visited close to 100 different sanctioned tracks over those years.

Tom writes a monthly column for "Inside IMCA Racing", the newsletter, distributed to all its members.
